PUBLIC MEETING

Application No. 655-15 Town of Wethersfield 1860 Reservoir, Highland St. Parcel # 050-001 Application for access drive maintenance within a regulated area.

Don Moisa presented the application.

The Town Manager and Town Councilors had received complaints from residents on the deteriorated condition of the access road to the 1860 Reservoir. We have also received letters from the Police Dept and the Fire Chief regarding the need for the access road to be passable for emergency and Police patrols.

The work would consist of leveling the tire ruts and potholes and cutting back any overhanging brush & vegetation, no trees to be removed.

Since a portion of the project falls within the 1860 Reservoir Encroachment Line a Inland Wetlands permit is required.

In 1995 the Town had done work on the road without a permit and was required to remove the material.

Commissioners questioned if haybale erosion control would be used.

Commissioners recommended that the project be done correctly any overspill be removed and any unsuitable material be removed and replaced with a processed stone base.

Motion by Commissioner Herold to Approve as a Summary Ruling with the following condition:

1. Haybale Erosion control to be added to both sides of the drive through the wet area during construction .

seconded by Commissioner Zagaja.

All voted in favor, motion passed.
