PUBLIC MEETING

Application No. 508-04, D'Esopo Funeral Chapel Inc. 227 Folly Brook Boulevard, Application to construct a pedestrian bridge across Folly Brook in a regulated area, to connect the existing funeral chapel with the new merchandising center.

Cory Garro of Close Jensen & Miller representing the D'Esopo Funeral Chapel Inc. presented plans for a 6' pedestrian walkway across Folly Brook.

Mr. Garro explained that the opening for the proposed walkway was larger than both the upstream Spruce St. Crossing and the downstream Rte . 5/15 crossing

Any dewatering or pumping during construction would be directed thru a silt sack or dirt bag to filter any sediment.

Motion by Commissioner Randazo, seconded by Commissioner Hallisey to APPROVE the application as a Summary ruling. All voted in favor. Motion passed.

Application No. 509-04 Town of Wethersfield, Kell-Strom Tool 208-214 Church St. Application to re-construct the existing headwall on the North Side of Church St.

Don Moisa presented plans for the re-construction/replacement of the headwall on the Kell-Strom Tool Property.

This application is the second phase of the application previously approved by the Inland Wetlands & Watercourses Commission for the reconstruction of Church Street.

Motion by Commisioner Hallisey,seconded by Commisioner Randazo to APPROVE the application as a Summary ruling with the following stipulations.

1. That the catch basins on Church St. at Beaver Brook be cleaned annually.

2. That the outlet on the south side of Church St. be cleaned 20' min. from the outlet.

All voted in favor. Motion Passed.
