Application No. 512-04, Great Meadow Conservation Trust, Parcel 213-013 & Parcel 212-004 to the rear of #416 & #408 Hartford Ave. Application seeking permit to do meadow restoration/habitat improvement/tree clearing work within a regulated area.

Jim Woodworth President of the Great Meadows Conservation Trust, Inc. presented a plan, letter, and photographs of the area and explained the historical use of the properties and the desire to do the meadow restoration and tree clearing to also comply with the terms of their easement to maintain the area as meadow and preserve the scenic view of the cove.

The work would be done by volunteers.
